AGE CLASSES

A competitor's age division is determined by his/her age at the day of the competition.

Pre-School – up to 6 years (only team performances)

Children – 7-11 years

- Juniors 12-15 years
- Adults 16 and over

NUMBER OF DANCERS

Team - 3-28 dancers

*Organizers have a right to separate small and big teams if necessary

- Small team - 3-9 dancers

- Big team - 10-28 dancers

Solo freestyle - 1 dancer

TIME LIMITS

Teams - 2:00 - 4:00

START FEES

First start 22 €, every other +10 eur (€)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Props and equipment must not cause any damage to the dance floor. The use of liquids, powders, body colors, or live fire on stage is strictly prohibited. Following the performance, it is imperative to leave the stage in the same pristine condition as it was before the show.

Participation in the competition is contingent upon the timely payment of participation fees.
Late registrations and changes are subject to an additional fee as outlined in a separate price list.

- In the event of an absence, organizers must be notified at least 90 minutes before the scheduled performance.

- Participation fees for a group or an individual dancer not taking part in the competition are non-refundable.

- Organizers retain the right to combine categories and age groups if deemed necessary.

- The organizers are authorized to utilize photos and videos captured during the competition at their discretion.

- Judges reserve the right to reassign a category or disqualify a performance if a unanimous decision is reached that the participant is in the wrong category.

- All contestants, teachers, and parents acknowledge that the judges' decisions are final and binding.

Street Dance Division

STREET DANCE SHOW

TEAMS

A show dance number put together by using various street dance styles. Other styles may be used, but the street style must dominate. The composition must have a theme or an idea.

Decorations, props and thematic costumes may be used to narrate the story.

Lifts and acrobatic elements are allowed but should not dominate.

HIP-HOP

TEAMS

A dance composition using primarily hip-hop technique and moves. Street dance styles such as hip-hop, house, vogue, brake, reggae, etc. are suitable. Different styles can be combined or limited to one style in one number.

Props and decorations are not allowed.

Focus is on technique, synchronization, musicality and rhythm.

Contemporary and Lyrical Division

CONTEMPORARY

<u>TEAMS</u>

An interpretive routine using a contemporary/modern style. In the competition realm, contemporary dance stands as a dynamic, boundary-pushing form that celebrates both technical prowess and personal expression. Contemporary dance, a captivating and expressive genre, seamlessly blends diverse movements rooted in dance fundamentals.

Props and decorations are allowed.

LYRICAL JAZZ

TEAMS

A dance style that embodies various aspects of ballet, jazz, acrobatics and modern dance. Composition involves the use of balance, flexibility and control utilizing the lyrics and feeling of the music. The focus is on jumps and turns characteristic of jazz dance and classical dance techniques.

Props and decorations are allowed.

Entertainment division

BROADWAY/CHARACTER DANCE

<u>TEAMS</u>

The routines with specific themes from different character dance styles. For example broadway, flamenco, show adaptations of different performance folk dance. Costumes, music and dance movements must be appropriate to the theme and storyline.

Props and decorations are allowed.

POP DANCE

<u>TEAMS</u>

Dance composition can mix different dance styles and create your own individual dance language based on different genres and techniques. The music used is usually different types of pop, electronic or any other mainstream style. The dances are generally vibrant and entertaining in nature and include shows in the broadest sense, offering the audience visual and artistic enjoyment.

Props and decorations are allowed.

Improvisation division

STREET DANCE

SOLO FREESTYLE

Improvisational category, organizers music, music tempo could vary in different speeds.

Focus is on dancer's sense of style, mastering different urban techniques, variety of movements, musicality, etc. Acrobatic and break dance elements (flips, flac, windmill, etc.) may be performed only with great caution.

In every round, dancers improvise two turns for approx. 1:00 per turn.

CONTEMPORARY DANCE

SOLO FREESTYLE

Improvisational category, organizers music, music tempo could vary in different speeds.

Focus is on dancer's personal body language, movements, emotions and musicality. Dancers can use and mix different dance styles. Acrobatic elements may be performed only with great caution and are not recommended.

In every round, dancers improvise two turns for approx. 1:00 per turn.
